The park is open all year from daylight until dark. The focus of the Gardens at Gantz Farm is herbs. There are 10 unique gardens including the Garden of Yesterday, Garden of Today and Garden of Tomorrow. Other special garden interest points feature culinary plants, herbal, oils used as fragrance, medicinal chemicals, pigments used to color natural fibers, knot garden, taxonomic groups and a cutting garden. A self-guided tour of the



gardens is available at the park or a brochure can be requested by mail. Gantz Park also has a playground, paved bicycle and walking trails, two tennis courts, a shelter houses and a large gazebo.
