Gardens at Gantz in Grove City

The Gardens at Gantz, 2255 Home Rd., Grove City, OH begins its 20th Anniversary celebration this year with the opening of a new meditational labyrinth. Gantz Park is a classroom of the natural world and a variety of classes are available for scheduled tour groups. Key elements include a developing arboretum, nature area with walking paths through a rolling terrain and by a meandering stream, tennis and basketball courts, a gazebo, shelter house, and a large playground for young children. The Gantz farmhouse is one of two sites in Grove City listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Adam Gantz built the house in 1832 as part of a 100-acre farm. Members of the Gantz family lived in the farmhouse until 1973 when the house and 10 acres were donated as a city park. Today the park is home to 10 unique herb gardens including the Gardens of Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow. Featured gardens include culinary, medicinal, fragrance, natural dye, knot, taxonomic and cuttings.
